

8.3 Application by St. Mary's Cement Inc. for a Permit to Take Water application with respect to Lot 3, Concession 11, East Flamborough.

Councillor McCarthy introduced the following Notice of Motion:

Whereas the City supports the Minister's Zoning Order with respect Part of Lot 1, and Lots 2 and 3 in Concession 11, East Flamborough made on April 12, 2010, which states:

"Every use of the land described in Section 1, and every erection, location or use of any building or structure on the land described in Section 1 is prohibited, except,

(a) uses, buildings and structures lawfully in existence on the date this Order comes into force; and

(b) the use of any land, building or structure that was permitted by the applicable zoning by-laws on the date this Order comes into force."

Whereas the Ministry of the Environment has refused an application by St. Mary's Cement Inc. for a Permit to Take Water application with respect to Lot 3, Concession 11, East Flamborough.

Whereas, the applicant has appealed the Ministry of the Environment's decision to refuse the Permit to Take Water application to the Environmental Review Tribunal.

That staff be directed and authorized to attend the Environmental Review Tribunal to ensure that the City's interests are safeguarded with respect to any decision on the Permit to Take Water application.
