WATERDOWN TRANSIT SERVICE

Route 18 – Waterdown will commence on Tuesday, September 2, 2008.

This route will operate on Weekdays during peak periods only, approximately 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. Buses will operate every 30 minutes. The schedule will coincide with the GO Train schedule and also the local schools' entrance and dismissal times.

The route starts at the Aldershot GO Station, travels along Waterdown Road and Mill Street and turns left on Highway #5, right on Highway #6, right on Parkside Drive, right on Evans Road, and right on Highway #5 back to Aldershot GO Station along Mill Street and Waterdown Road. Bus stops will be located along the route closer to the start date.

Fare Integration with GO Transit and Burlington Transit – When you purchase a GO Monthly Pass you can purchase an HSR Sticker for \$15.00 which entitles you to unlimited use on HSR routes. This sticker must be purchased at the same time as you purchase your GO Monthly Pass. For more information on GO Transit, contact them at 1-888-538-6646 or www.gotransit.ca.

If you are traveling on both HSR and Burlington Transit (BT) buses, pay your fare when boarding the bus and ask for a transfer. HSR Operators will honour BT transfers and BT Operators will accept HSR transfers when you are transferring between the two services at the Aldershot GO Station.
