Dear Bill:

I see from the package of materials that was forwarded by the MOE archived file records for 475 Concession 11, and note that Fine Analysis Laboratories had done the majority of lab work for that property.

You may recall that this company was charged and convicted with offences with respect to it's work. The logged complaints and charges laid by the Hamilton Police Department date back to the time when work was done on the file of contamination for the property now owned by St. Marys. In fact convictions for fraudulent lab results after a three year investigation of Fine Analysis Laboratories who did the work for the said property obviously raises some serious concerns regarding the validity of those tests.

It is my understanding that the police files of the Fine Analysis fraud investigation have been turned over to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment to see if there is evidence to support further charges of conspiracy to commit fraud by clients of the lab.

I would like to obtain all the information regarding the files that the Ministry of Environment has on this issue, as I have only been able to research based on published articles from the Canadian Press, The Hamilton Spectator, Sierra Club Canada, and a posted letter to then Minister Tony Clement dated 1999.

Any and all information you have regarding this issue, I would greatly appreciate.
