St. Marys Cement says it expects to begin the first of three controversial water-pumping tests on or about July 21.

Pumping from wells on the company's proposed quarry site on 11th Concession East at Milborough Line will go from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. for a maximum of eight days.

General manager John Moroz says St. Marys will respond immediately to any questions or concerns.

"Safeguards are in place as part of the (Environment Ministry) permit to ensure that water quality and quantity will not be impacted. The site will be continually monitored during the testing, and I encourage residents to contact us."
