Subject: St. Mary's PTTW Application - Mid-March Expected Decision Timeline CHANGED AGAIN

Councillor McCarthy is sending this further update on the PTTW application as follows:

"It has been brought to our attention that Cora Shepard who was the administrative contact person at the MOE for this application has been reassigned to another department replacing her is Joan Del Villar Cuicas.

In a conversation with this office Carl Slater, Technical Support Manager with the MOE, expects further delays in the final decision for the St. Mary's PTTW application. He states that further delays are not the result of staff changes at the MOE but the result of St. Mary's being slow to provide the additional requested information by the MOE. Once this additional information is finally provided further study could result in additional delays perhaps into the summer.

Although many of us may find this process agonizingly slow, the fact that it has not been approved and is being taken this seriously by the MOE is still good news for us. Over 600 public submissions have been received by the MOE from Flamborough residents to date, a very good indication of the level of concern from our community on this critical issue.

Mr. Slater confirmed that the signing director dealing with the application by St. Mary's is still Paul Odom who has a technical staff that report to him on all aspects of the application and therefore feels this minor staffing change will not effect the processing of information.

As always we will keep you up-to-date with any information as it becomes available.
